## **Nuremberg Academy Lectures**

## by Professor William Schabas

In this timely lecture, Professor William Schabas, a world-renowned scholar on genocide, will assess the legacy and modern relevance of the Genocide Convention, the first ever human rights treaty adopted by the United Nations General Assembly. The lecture will also explore the scope of crucial elements of the Convention which remain largely unexplored in international case law such as the duty to prevent genocide and acts of genocide involving prevention or births and transfer of children.



Professor William Schabas is Professor of International Law at Middlesex University in London, Emeritus Professor at Leiden University and Distinguished Visiting Fellow at the Paris School of International Affairs, Sciences Po. He is Professor Emeritus at the National University of Ireland Galway and Honorary Chairman of the Irish Centre for Human Rights. He is the author of more than twenty books in the fields of human rights and international criminal law, including Oxford Commentaries on the Rome Statute and the European Convention on Human Rights. Professor Schabas has prepared the quinquennial reports on the death penalty for the United Nations Secretary-General. He was a member of the Sierra Leone Truth and Reconciliation Commission. Professor Schabas is an Officer of the Order of Canada and a member of the Royal Irish Academy and holds several honorary doctorates.

The *Nuremberg Academy Lectures* explore topical issues at the intersection of international criminal law, transitional justice and policy. The International Nuremberg Principles Academy invites leading scholars and practitioners to deliver a lecture and engage in dialogue. Through its public lecture series featuring speakers of national and international renown, the International Nuremberg Principles Academy provides a forum for discussion around contemporary issues in international criminal law and promotes public understanding of international law.

The lecture series was launched in 2020 marking the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the formulation of the Nuremberg Principles. All lectures will be available on the YouTube channel of the Nuremberg Academy.
